

**Master Bibliography - Witchcraft and Human Rights**  
The Norman Miller Collection  
An East African Archive

This bibliography represents sources collected by Norman Miller from 1960-2015 in his research on witchcraft and human rights. It is an uncorrected draft bibliography of materials and citations in the Miller Collection. The bibliography was compiled by Franny Eanet, Katrina Wheelan, Sarah MacCormick, and Maddie Lyons in 2017 from Miller's earlier field work.

The most extensive bibliography on the history of witchcraft was compiled by Dr. Roma Standefer of Ottawa, Canada, as part of her doctoral dissertation: "African witchcraft beliefs: a study in comparative symbolic classification," University of Oxford, 1972 ([http://solo.bodleian.ox.ac.uk/OXVU1:LSCOP\\_OX:oxfaleph01346688](http://solo.bodleian.ox.ac.uk/OXVU1:LSCOP_OX:oxfaleph01346688)), which includes a 63-page bibliography of some 900 sources from 1900-1971.
